

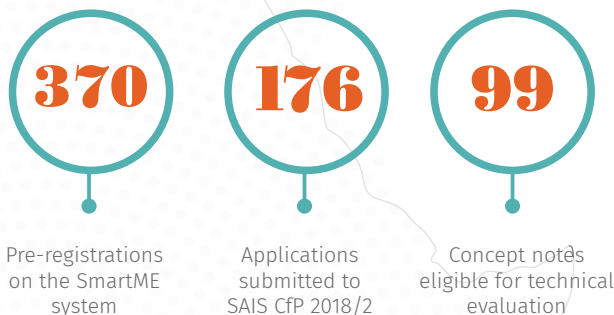


STAGE 1: CONCEPT NOTE

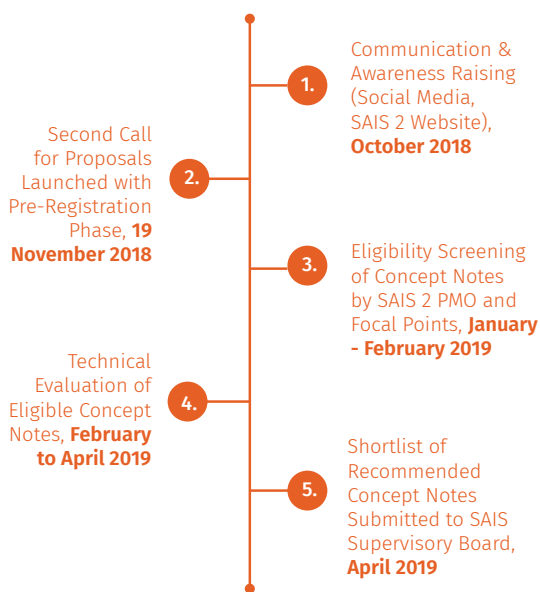
The Southern Africa Innovation Support Programme (SAIS 2), supports early-stage entrepreneurs and ecosystems of innovation at the local and transnational level.

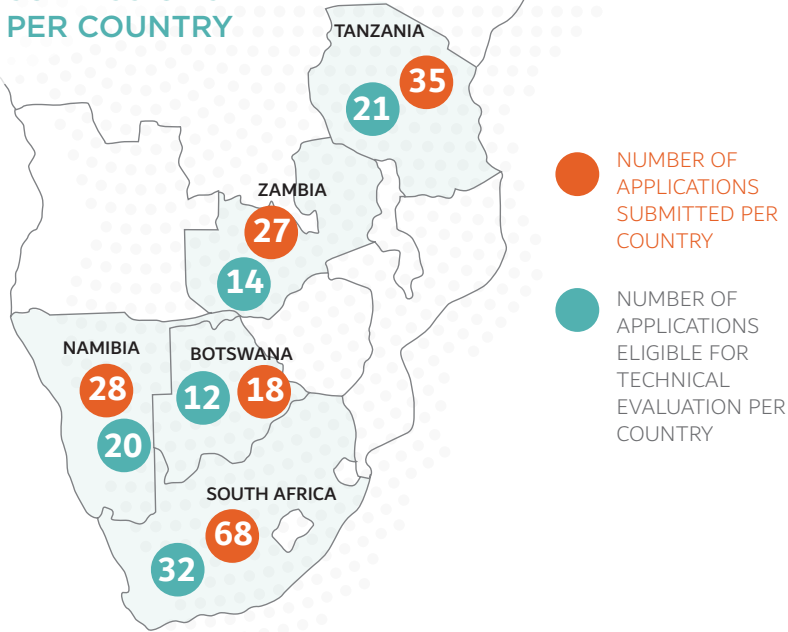
The second SAIS 2 call for proposals continues to fund projects in three thematic areas: stronger ecosystems, scaling enterprises, and inclusive innovations.

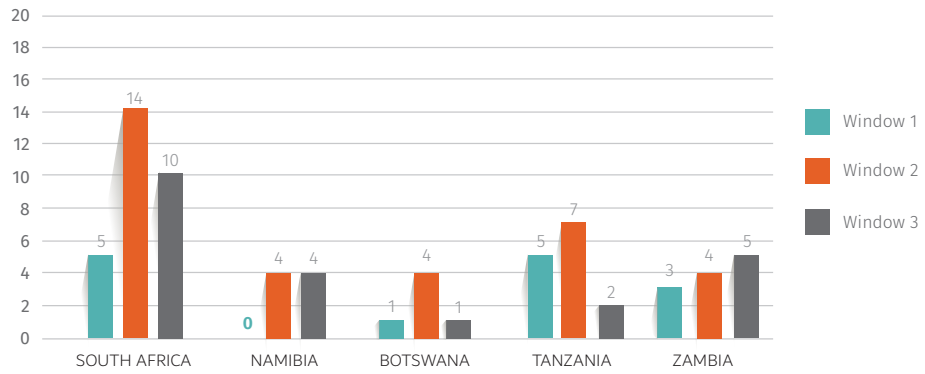
SUBMISSIONS PER COUNTRY



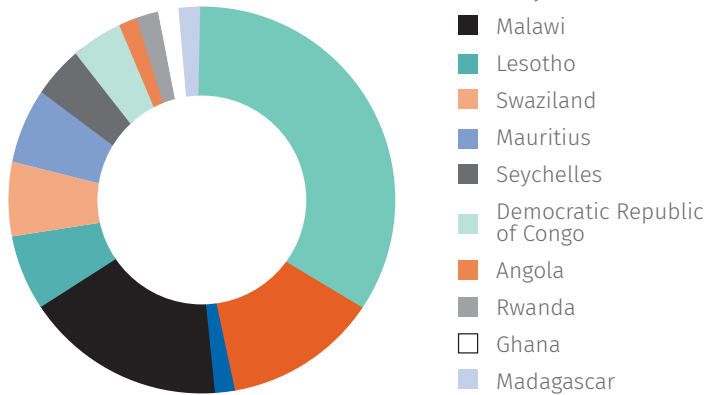

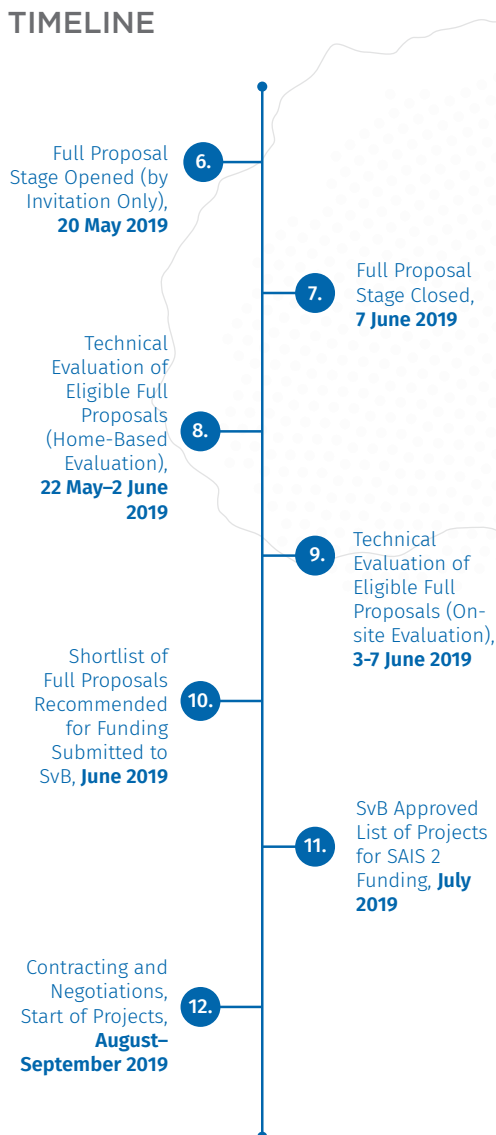

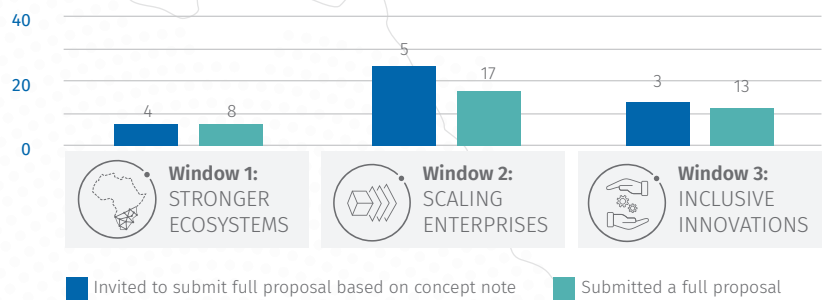

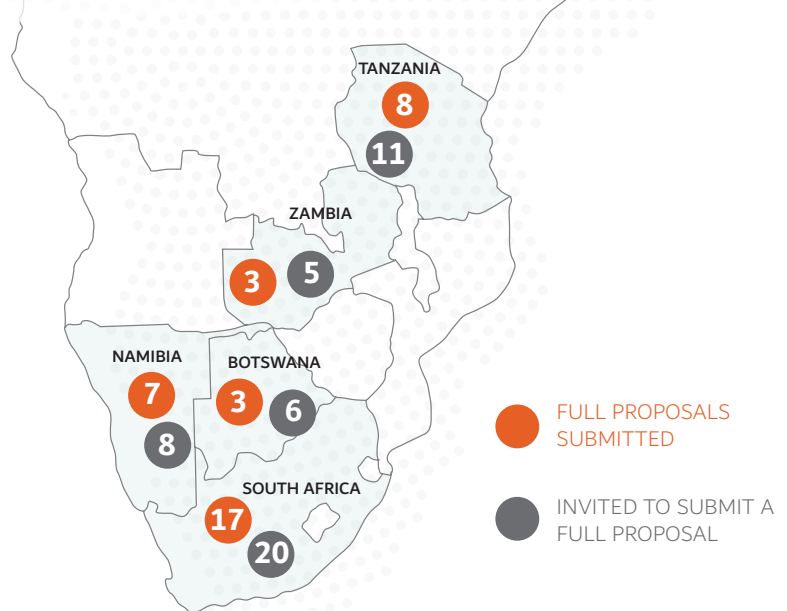

APPLICANTS INVITED FOR FULL PROPOSAL STAGE AND FULL PROPOSALS RECEIVED PER COUNTRY

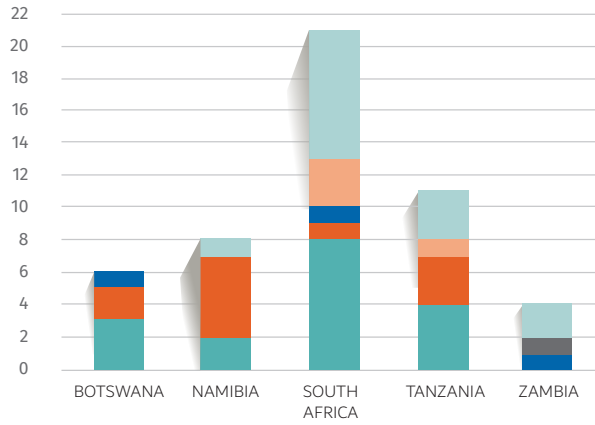

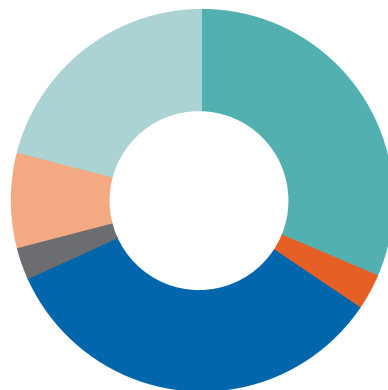

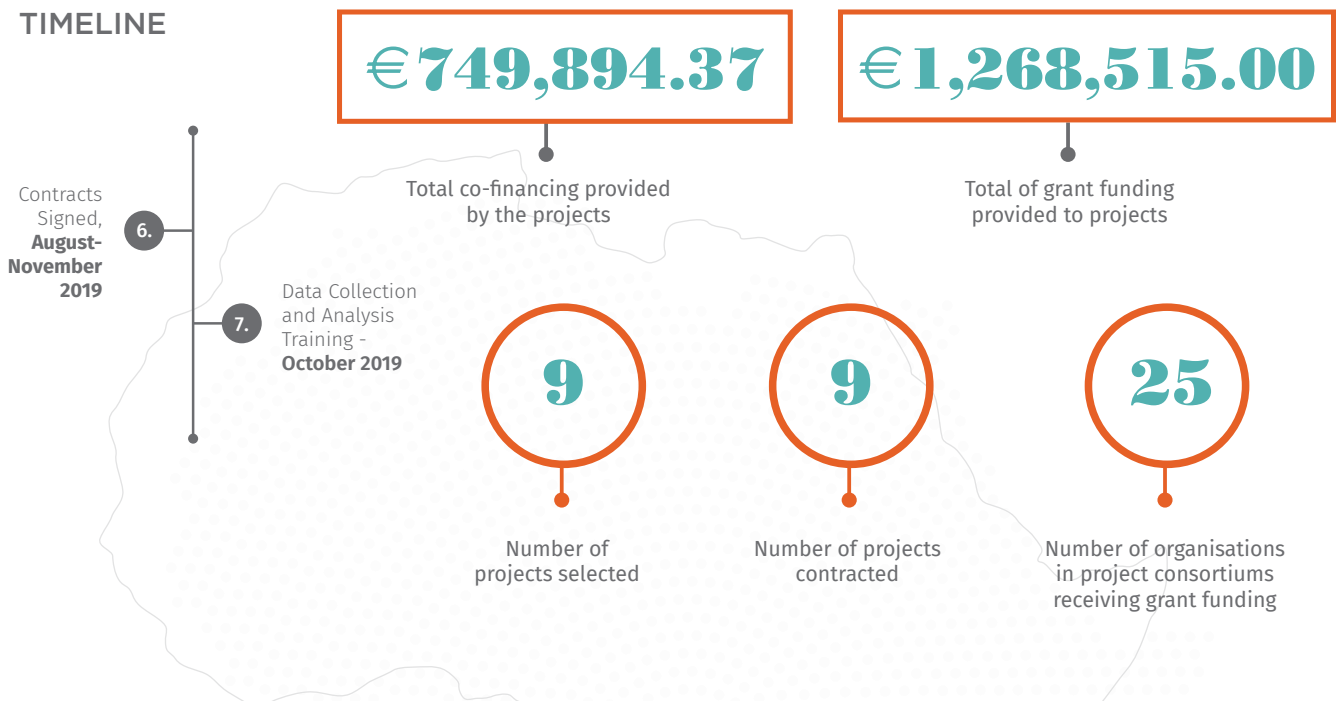

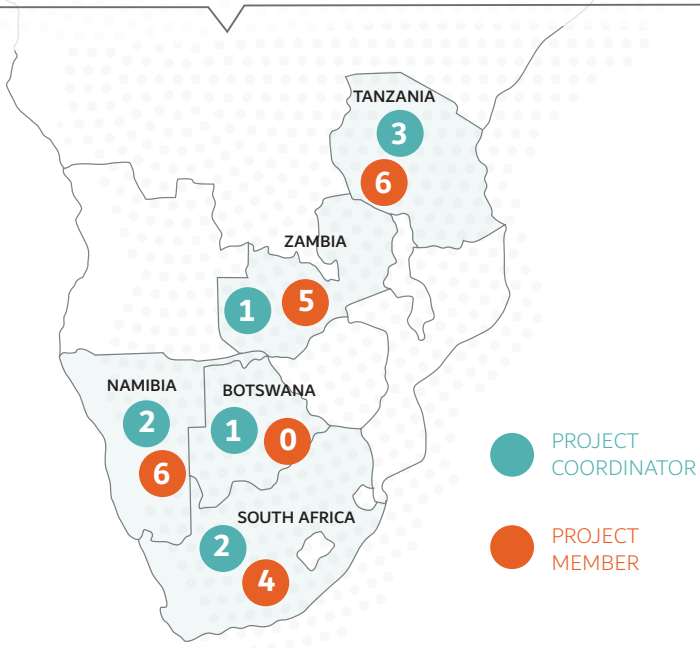
